Our annual meeting is rapidly approaching and I want to give you a quick update on your club. The meeting will be held Saturday, December 6th at 1:00 pm. Lunch will be provided beginning at 12:30 pm. Up for election are the president and treasurer positions as well as one board seat. In summary, our club has had another great year. We are on track to throw between 500,000 and 600,000 targets. Our financial position remains strong as we have been able to fund a couple of large projects in 2025 with cash and we continue to be debt free. Additional financial details and results will be provided at the meeting.

We are putting the finishing touches on the construction of an enclosed and heated 5-stand field. This project is part of a three-way collaboration between KOSKO, The Midway USA Foundation, and Grace College. It is fully functional and we look to get great use from it this winter and for years to come.

During the year, we also purchased over a dozen additional sporting clays machines. Some were part of the 5-stand project and, in the end, it has allowed us to put four machines at every sporting clays station. Having four machines allows us to provide targets for all skill levels at all times.

In 2025, we completed the installation of all of the wooden sporting clays stations. These stations were funded by sponsors. Please take note of these organizations as you shoot the course and try to support these businesses.

KOSKO continues to support a number of organizations that promote our sport. We also continue to invest in our youth programs – Grace, The Dust Devils, 4-H, Warsaw Public Schools, Pheasants Forever youth, etc. etc. These programs are showing their strongest numbers ever.

In 2025, we have also seen the popularity of special and corporate events grow. At times, this requires us to close the club for a day. We make every attempt to keep as much of the club open as possible during these events and to provide as much notice when certain fields will be closed. These events are important to KOSKO financially and are a great way to introduce more potential members to our club.

Speaking about membership, we recently surpassed 400 members! This is a fantastic accomplishment and each and every one of us can help spread the word and be welcoming to our visitors/guests when they come to KOSKO.
